

Privacy Policy

In order to provide these services, we collect and process certain personal data, thereby assuming the role of data controller. By submitting your contact information or identity documents to us, you consent to the processing of your personal data. We process your information strictly in accordance with applicable laws and regulations and use it solely for the purpose of delivering our services, with full respect for your privacy and data security as outlined in this Privacy Policy.

The Company collects and processes your personal information to fulfill the services described above. If such consent is not granted, the Company will cease processing your data in accordance with applicable laws and regulations.
